### KTCR Expert Encyclopedia - Second Edition

The KTCR Expert Encyclopedia - Second Edition is designed to be a comprehensive guide to testimonial appearances by expert witnesses in civil jury trials in Kentucky. The data is sorted in three indexes. The first index, referred to as the **Main Expert Index**, is the heart of the book. Sort alphabetically, the Main Expert Index in a snapshot look provides a summary of every expert's trial appearances.

This index of nearly 3,194 entries is sorted by the following fields, the expert's name, location and expertise. It also describes for the purpose that he was hired, commonly, Defense IME or Plaintiff standard of care. The next column describes what his testimony was about, where it be a surgical error or cause of death. The index continues and lists the hiring attorney, the underlying case style, the year of the verdict and its KTCR reference number. [That reference number refers the reader to our original verdict report.]

The Main Expert Index further describes the verdict result, the jurisdiction and the case number. Thus the reader has a variety of methods (all via the index) to learn more about a particular testimonial appearance. Besides our KTCR case number (our original verdict report), the inclusion of the case style and number unlocks the location of the original court file and all that comes with that, including any written depositions that might be filed (video depositions that become of the court record) and any other pleadings, including CR 26 disclosures. [Readers will note the Main Expert Index is presented in a sideways format – this was accomplished to put as much data about the expert on a single line.]

The second index in this book is by **expertise**. It sorts the data by a particular expert's expertise. Thus a reader that was looking for an accident reconstructionist or an infectious disease doctor or a human factors expert, or any other sort of expert, can look generally. [This index is sorted alphabetically by area of expertise.] While this index is abbreviated, for more information on a particular expert, simply turn back to the Main Expert Index for the details on that expert's testimonial appearance.

The third index is by **attorney**. Sorted alphabetically by attorney, it lists the experts as hired by attorneys. The questions answered by this index are simple – has a certain expert worked for his present hiring counsel before and in what sort of cases. Like the index by expertise, for the complete details on a particular appearance, refer back to the Main Expert Index.

The scope of our index covers all verdicts reported by the KTCR from 2001 through the March 2011 issue. The purpose of this limitation (10.2 years) was to address the staleness of testimony. Readers will also note that certain experts sometimes list different locations. Our data is drawn from the original verdict reports and experts over time do move around.

The perfunctory introductions out of the way, what sort of questions can be answered with by this book The following list is not meant to be exhaustive:

- (1) How many times has an expert testified at trial? In what sorts of cases? Consult the Main Expert Index.
- (2) I want to obtain an expert's depositions from trial or discovery? In the Main Expert Index, we have listed the jurisdiction, the case style and the case number so that court record may be identified.
  - (3) Which counsel has hired certain experts? Consult the attorney index.
- (4) How has a certain expert fared at trial? While that question is not as simple as the verdict, the Main Expert Index describes the expert's expertise and opinion as well as the verdict result. In a standard of care case, did the expert's opinion ultimately prevail? In a Defense IME appearance, was a large verdict returned for the plaintiff? Or a threshold?
  - (5) Looking for a certain type of expert? Pathology in a birth injury case? Consult the index by expertise.

It is important to note that this book makes no comment on expert appearances in cases that were not tried.
